POMONA COLLEGE AND THE UNIVERSITY TO CONTEST.

The University of Southern California will send its track athletic team to Pomona today to contest with the representatives of Pomona College. The meet will be held in the new Athletic Park at Pomona, which has been specially prepared for this event. A new five-lap track has been put in. Cinder paths have been laid for the short runs and hurdle race. The meeting of the college athletes has attracted much attention.

Quite a delegation will go out from Los Angeles to witness the games. The University team comprises about twenty athletes, all carefully trained for the contests.

Each college enters two men in every event. The programme, with the entries from the two schools, is as follows:

Two-hundred-and-twenty-yard dash: Pomona, Avery and Lamb; U.S.C., Russell Ferguson and Van Den Bergh.

Running broad jump: Pomona, Wharton and Bixby; U.S.C., Miller and J. S. Ferguson.

One-mile run: Pomona, Hinckley and Adams; U.S.C., Crowell and Flint.

One-hundred-yard dash: Pomona, Lamb and Avery; U.S.C., Van Den Bergh and Miller.

Putting 16-pound shot: Pomona, Suydam and King; U.S.C., Freeman and N. G. Guiberson.

One-hundred-and-twenty-yard hurdle race: Pomona, Gowan and Wharton; U.S.C., W. R. Guiberson and Broderson.

Pole vault: Pomona, Sloan and Voorhies; U.S.C., Knoles and J. S. Ferguson.

Four-hundred-and-forty-yard run: Pomona, Adams and Avery; U.S.C., Smith and Russell Ferguson.

Throwing 16-pound hammer: Pomona, Venhuizen and Bradley; U.S.C., N. G. Guiberson and Freeman.

Running high jump: Pomona, Palmer and Wharton; U.S.C., J. S. Ferguson and Miller.

One-mile relay in quarter-mile relays: Pomona team, Hinckley, Gowan Adams and Fairchild; U.S.C. team, Van Den Bergh, Russell Ferguson, Oates and Smith.
