

Los Angeles Boy After World's Record.



Winnie Cutter, Crack All 'Round Athlete.

Winnie Cutter, last year one of Mique Fisher's incubator pitchers, and this spring a coach at U.S.C., has been in training for the all-around champion athletic competition at the World's Fair this summer, in which he is to take a part. Cutter's friends are wondering who bids fair to beat him as an all-around athlete, and the consensus of opinion is that the ball player has an excellent chance to win.

Elbery H. Clark, who won the title of being the best all-around athlete in the country at the last competition, will probably be Cutter's most dangerous opponent, and the versatile young pitcher feels confident he can dispose of Clark easily enough, judging by what he did when he won.

Cutter expects to go after the world's record with the hammer and is very likely to get it. He throws in splendid form, and is said to have scored 187 feet in practice at Agricultural Park with the twelve-pounder—a record which, if reliable, is the money. He will make an arrangement with Henry Harris, manager of the San Francisco ball club, for which he is to pitch this year, and will probably have no diffi-

culty in getting off the time necessary to compete.

Cutter is an adept at pole vaulting, and displays the same peculiarities of form in going over the bar as in his other specialties; the accompanying snap shots show it better than words. He was figuring up his prospects the other night and set them down as follows for the various events, in comparison with Clark's records the year he won the all-around championship. Here is the list:

These events will be decided with five minutes' rest between, scoring to be done on a basis of 1000 points, 14 2-7 off for each one-fifth second in the time events. Two or three of the events will be new to Cutter, but he expects to practice all of them.
