

POMONA WINS TRACK HONORS.

U.S.C. GOES DOWN TO DEFEAT AT CLAREMONT MEET.

Two Southern California Intercollegiate Records, the High Jump and the Mile Relay Are Broken by the Country Boys—Los Angeles Contestants Make Poor Showing.

CLAREMONT, March 3.—[Exclusive Dispatch.] Pomona, 73 5-6; U.S.C., 48 1-6.

U.S.C. and Pomona met this afternoon in a track athletic meet, the first one between the two schools for four years. The best of friendly feeling was shown by each school, each one repeatedly cheering the other's contestants. Two Southern California intercollegiate records were broken. Munger, for Pomona, jumped 5 ft. 11 in., breaking the intercollegiate record of 5 ft. 9 in. The relay team for Pomona, consisting of McKee, Spurgeon, Bishop and Brown, broke the intercollegiate record in the mile relay in the fast time of 3m. 36s. The events:

120-yard high hurdles, won by Breittkreutz (U.S.C.) Elliott (U.S.C.) second, Wharton (Pomona) third; time 12s.

100-yard dash—Cree (U.S.C.) won, Spurgeon (Pomona) second, Wilson (U.S.C.) and Baird (Pomona) tied for third; time 10 3-5a.

Mile run—Won by Lorbeer (Pomona,) Breittkreutz (U.S.C.) second, Himrod (Pomona) third; time 4m. 55 4-5s.

440-yard dash—Won by McKee (Pomona,) Chisholm (Pomona) second, Higgins (U.S.C.) third; time 54s.

220-yard hurdle—Won by Bishop (Pomona,) Elliott (U.S.C.) second, Spurgeon (Pomona) third; time 27s.

220-yard dash—Cree (U.S.C.) won, Wilson (U.S.C.) second, Cooper (U.S.C.) third; time 23 1-5s.

Half-mile run—Brown (Pomona) won, Breittkreutz (U.S.C.) second, Higgins (U.S.C.) third; time 2m. 10s.

Two-mile run—Won by Johnson (Pomona,) Lorbeer (Pomona) second, Hubbard (U.S.C.) third; time 10m. 47 1-5s.

Relay race—Pomona team, composed of McKee, Spurgeon, Bishop, Brown, won; time 3m. 36s.

Pole vault—Won by Comstock (U.S.C.) Davis and Vaile of Pomona tied for second place; height, 10 ft.

Hammer throw—Moorman (Pomona) won, Metcalf (Pomona) second, Goode (Pomona) third; distance, 124 ft. 2 in.

High jump—Won by Munger (Pomona,) Bishop (Pomona) second, Comstock (U.S.C.) Haigler (U.S.C.) and Thomas (Pomona) tied for third place; height, 5 ft. 11 in.
