

OXY TIGERS EASILY

TAKE Y. M. C. A. MEET.

PACIFIC GROVE, April 6.—The Occidental College students present at the Y.M.C.A. conference here practically clinched their hold on the citizen's trophy cup yesterday afternoon when they trotted away with the track meet with a score of 85½ points to 11½ scored by Pomona, their nearest competitors. This is the second time that the Tigers have won the cup and once more win will make it theirs permanently.

As the track was newly laid out and rather rough, the times made were not wonderful and the distances run were not always accurately measured. Occidental was materially helped by the presence of several of their track athletes who came to the conference after the meet with California.

The Pacific Grove hotel cup for the largest individual point winner went to Harry Kirkpatrick of Occidental, who entered seven events and of these won five, tied for first in the high jump and took second in the discus throw. He won both dashes, both hurdles and the broad jump, not to mention throwing the discus ninety-four feet and high jumping 5ft. 7ins. Occidental won every first place.

High jump—Kirkpatrick (O.) and Creighton (O.) tied for first, Wieman (O.) and Lorbeer (P.) tied for third.

The 220-yard hurdles—Kirkpatrick (O.) first, Rushforth (C.) and Dill (O.) tied for second.

Pole vault—Wilson (O.) first, Cammack (W.) second, Watson (U.S.C.) third.

Discus throw—Wieman (O.) first, Kirkpatrick (O.) second, Locke (U.S.C.) third.

Broad jump—Kirkpatrick (O.) first, Dill (O.) second, Cook (O.) third.

Relay—Won by Occidental, U.S.C. second, Whittier third.
