WIN TRACK MEET.

The U.S.C. freshmen had a close squeak Friday in their first track meet of the season, but managed to win from Hollywood by the score of 62½ points to 59½. The meet was held on the slow Hollywood track, with the result that the time was slower than usual. Burrell of Hollywood was the most impressive performer. He made the 440 in 54 seconds, which is fast for this early in the season and exceptionally so on the slow track. The results:
