

PADDOCK IS STAR OF MEET.

*Youngsters Break into Real
Fast Company.*

*Big Crowd Sees A.A.U. Relay
Carnival.*

*Plenty of Tobasco Shown on
Bovard Field.*

"Speed" Paddock, fast boy of Pasadena High School, kept up his record at the A.A.U. carnival in Bovard Field yesterday by annexing his usual quantity of gold medals in the sprints. In the 100-yard dash for class No. 1 high schools he stepped away from his old friend, Woods, of Manual, and broke the tape at 10s. flat. About ten minutes later the youngster repeated his performance in the open hundred, again tacking up a record of 10 flat.

Adkinson ran his usual little race in the one-mile, four-man relay and tacked an easy five points on to the Pomona College score by coming in several yards ahead of U.S.C.'s last man. In the pole vault Maurer got up in the air with a winning leap of 11ft. 7in., while Draper of San Bernardino High School broke into the limelight when he took first in the open high jump with a hop of 5ft. 10 3/4 in.

The meet was run off in snappy style, thanks to the work of Dean Cromwell, who popped the gun; Charley Keppen, and Coach Vic Ligda of Manual Arts. The results:
