

PADDOCK AND MURRAY STAR.

*Trojan Sprinter Takes Two
First Places.*

*Beats Even Time in Both of
the Dash Races.*

*Record Falls Before Quaker
Hurdle Demon.*

CLAREMONT, April 12. — Charley Paddock of the University of Southern California and Verle Murray of Whittier College provided the red-hot performances of the A.A.U. meet on the Pomona College field this afternoon, each of them hanging up sensational time in their favorite events.

Paddock, the wonderful Trojan freshman, cleaned up both of the sprinting events and, as had been predicted by local enthusiasts, was forced by Homer Chaney of Pomona College to break even time in both the century and the furlong, winning the 100-yard dash by inches in 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ s. and the 220-yard dash by a wider margin in 21 $\frac{1}{8}$ s. He was flying along in wonderful form.

Murray, the sole entrant of Whittier College, likewise was forced along to fast time by hot competition, the same being furnished by Mike Yount of Redlands, George Gansner of U.S.C. and Draper of Redlands. The Quaker obstacle racer negotiated the shorter race in the fast time of 15 $\frac{3}{8}$ s. and then utterly and totally ruined the Southern California record over the low sticks by covering the 220 yards in 24s. flat.

The meet was won by the University of Southern California track team by a rather large margin—Paddock, Schiller and one or two other men contributing to the big score. The Los Angeles Athletic Club, by grabbing a lot of points in the field events, took second place. High school runners upset the dope in a number of events, particularly the distances.
