

CARDS SMEAR TROJANS HARD.

*Stanford's Brawn and Speed
Too Much for U. of S.C.*

*Paddock Brings Consolation
by Copping Sprints.*

*Wells of Northerners Invincible
in the Hurdles.*

STANFORD UNIVERSITY, April 8.—The Stanford University track team defeated the University of Southern California, 77 to 45, in their second meet of the season today. Paddock, U.S.C., sprinter, won both the 100-yard and 220-yard dashes, the feature events. Capt. Wells of Stanford with a total of 11 was the biggest point winner.

Paddock's time was 10 seconds flat in the century and 21 3-5 seconds in the 220. Previously this season he has done the 100-yard in 9 4-5, but a strong wind blowing slowed him up. Kirksey of Stanford, also credited with 9 4-5, finished only inches behind in the shorter sprint, but was outdistanced by several feet in the 220-yard event.

Wells won both hurdles and was third in the 100-yard dash. Paddock and Evans, also of U.S.C., tied with 10 each for second point winner. Evans won the shot put and discus throw.

The half-mile race was won by George, U.S.C., Carlsmith, Stanford, and Mickey, U.S.C., led the field until the stretch, when George forged ahead in a thrilling finish. It was the hardest fought event of the meet.

Pole vault: Green (S.) first, Wilcox (S.) second, Dweing (S.) third. Height 12ft.

Shot put: Evans (U.S.C.) first, Adams (S.) second, Hanner (S.) third. Distance 39ft. 2 in.

Discus: Evans (U.S.C.) first, Gillespie (S.) second, Green (S.) third. Distance 130ft. 7 1/2 in.

1-mile relay: Won by U.S.C., with Wilcox, Wilson, Isenhouer, Schiller. Time 3m. 30 3-5.
