

HONORS IN RELAY TO TROJANS.

*U. of W. Grabs Carnival at
Seattle with Twenty-two
Points; Oregon Second.*

STADIUM, SEATTLE (Wash.)

April 23.—University of Washington, with twenty-two points, won the annual Washington relay carnival today. Oregon Agricultural College was second with twelve points and University of Southern California third, with ten. University of Oregon scored seven points, University of Idaho, four; Whitman College, 3, and Washington State College, 1. Montana Wesleyan University failed to place. Arthur Tuck of University of Oregon won the pentathlon, feature event of the meet.

The rain, light at first, increased to a downpour and the field became very muddy. The track held fairly firm, but was slow. The summaries:

Four-mile relay race—Won by O. A. C. (Dawson, Hobart, Scea, Sims;) U. of W. (Foster, Johnson, Wright, Meisnest,) second. Time, 19m. 14 3-5a. (Only two entries.)

100-yard dash—Hurley (U. of W.,) first; Anderson (U. of W.,) second; Sterling (Montana,) third. Time, 10 2-5a.

Half-mile relay—U. S. C. (Isenhouer, Leahy, Wilson and Schiller,) first; U. of W. (Hathway, Pratt, Metlen and Laudy,) second; O. A. C. (Rose, Kellogg, Scea and Cook,) third. Time, 1m. 32 2-5a.

Two-mile relay—U. of W. (Davis, Douglas, Deall and Williams,) first; O. A. C. (Deigh, Richard, Rose and Sims,) second; Idaho (Van Hoesen, Macey, Gill and Hersch,) third; U. S. C. (Rowles, Davis, Maurer and Michel,) fourth. Time, 3m. 22 2-5a.

Mile relay—U. S. C. (Isenhouer, Leigh, Wilson and Schiller,) first; U. of W. (Metlen, Pratt, Laudy and Douglas,) second; Oregon (Sundale, Collins, Hallip and Larson,) third; O. A. C. (Hollinger, Scea, Kellogg and Rose,) fourth. Time, 3m. 30 4-5a.

Pentathlon—Won by Tuck (Oregon,) 3,111,261 points; Dement, (Whitman,) second, 2,744,932; Perrine (Idaho,) third, 2,515,524; MacGoman (Montana,) fourth, 2,485,500.
