

# CARDS HUMBLE TROJAN SQUAD.

*Stanford Trackmen Easily  
Win, 85 to 46.*

*Hartranft Star Performer in  
Dual Meet.*

*New Coast Record Set in the  
Discus Throw.*

Rhino Hartranft, the blond behemoth of Fullerton, ran amuck at U. S. C. yesterday and with three firsts and a third succeeded in greatly assisting the Stanford University track and field team to swat the U. S. C. aggregation of time and space annihilators by the robust score of 85 to 46.

Mr. Hartranft opened the day's festivities by tossing the 16-pound shot some 49ft. 7½ in., just eight feet better than the winner of second place. About that time somebody suggested that the hundred yard dash was about to start so the peroxide giant ambled over to the cinders and ran away from the field, looking over his shoulder, in 16 seconds flat. He then set a new Coast record in the discus of 147ft. 1½ in. and wound up by loafing into third place in the furlong.

## COLLAPSES AT FINISH.

Other prominent young men in the point-winning line were George Schiller and Cap Rogers of U. S. C. George captured the quarter mile without spraining anything in 50 1-5 seconds and then tore off a hot furlong in 22 2-5 seconds. Capt. Rogers ran himself into a state of complete collapse in winning the low hurdles in 26 flat but gathered himself together long enough to win the broad jump with a wild lunge of 22ft. 11-4in.

The only other athlete to win a first for U. S. C. was Neil Raney who took the high hurdles when Falk of Stanford was disqualified for tipping over too many. Capt. Flint Hanner of Stanford threw the javelin almost out of sight, tossing the toothpick 185ft. 7½ in. in an exhibition throw. Stanford took all three places in this event and in the half-mile and hundred yard dash.
