

# BEARS HUMBLE TROJANS AGAIN

*Southerners Lose Track  
Meet, 91 to 35*

*U.S.C. Only Enters Eight  
Men in Affair*

*Hutchinson Beats Schiller in  
Century Dash*

BERKELEY, April 8.—The University of California won the second track meet of the year with the University of Southern California this afternoon by a score of 91 to 35.

Only eight men were entered in the meet by U.S.C. and in several events the southerners were not represented. Today's defeat was the second administered the Trojans by the Bears this year, the northerners having won a dual meet in Los Angeles, March 18, by a 93-38 score.

## FANS DISAPPOINTED.

Schiller, crack southern runner, disappointed track fans when he did not enter the 440-yard run, an event he won in the Los Angeles meet from McDonald and Hendrixson, California stars.

In the 100-yard dash, however, Schiller forced Bob Hutchinson, California captain, to extend himself and the latter won in 9 4-5a., the fastest time made on the Coast in this event this year.
