

# FROSH RAPS HOLLYWOOD

U.S.C.'s crack freshman trackin a City League dual meet this season. team took the hitherto undefeated Hollywood High cinderpath artists down the line, 84 to 29, yesterday afternoon in a torrid dual meet on Bouvard Field. The Foot-hillers put up a strong fight for every point and succeeded in grabbing two firsts and the relay from the classy Peagreeners.

Bud Houser put in a good day's work in the two weight events, winning the discus with a remarkable throw of 144ft., and grabbing the shotput with a toss of 53ft., 1 1-4 in. Mike Elwood rambled in winner in the mile for the frosh, in the fast time of 4:46 3-5. Barnes of Hollywood cleared the bar in the pole vault at the winning heighth of 11ft. The Hollywooders cut loose in the relay and grabbed the eight-man affair from the speedy Peagreen aggregation in 3:10 3-5, the fastest time made in the baton event
