

TROJAN STARS WILL COMPETE

Cory-Emmons Will Perform for U.S.C. Varsity

A.A.U. Meet at Redlands to be Hard Fought

Feg Murray and Fred Kelly Set for Races

Chances of victory for the University of Southern California for the University of Southern California varsity in the annual A.A.U. track and field championships at Redlands tomorrow loom brighter and brighter as the minutes pass. Oliver Cory, star high jumper, and Dick Emmons, Trojan pole vaulter, will compete for U.S.C. in tomorrow's meet, according to announce-

ment made yesterday by Coach Dean Cromwell.

The addition of Cory and Emmons to the Trojan ranks should swell the varsity total of points by about seven digits. All of which will be sad news to the Los Angeles Athletic Club, Occidental, Pomona, and U.S.C. frosh track squads.

Feg Murray and Fred Kelly, America's oldest foremost hurdlers, have been pronounced in perfect condition by their host of trainers and conditioners, and should break at least seven world's records in their two exhibition hurdle races tomorrow. Both have a host of verbal backers, but no money has been wagered on the outcome of their races as yet, so much is the outcome in doubt.

BOTH CONFIDENT

When Feg Murray was recently asked what he thought the outcome of the races would be, he replied, "No baldheaded hurdler like Fred Kelly could ever beat me. I expect Kelly will withdraw before the races really start."

However, Kelly stated, when told of Feg's remarks, that Murray would be lucky to second tomorrow.

Tomorrow's meet starts promptly at 1 o'clock, the hammer throw being the opening event. There will be twenty-one events, not counting the exhibition hurdle races between Kelly and Murray, tomorrow, and it is expected that the meet will end a little before 5:30 o'clock.

HURDLES FEATURE

The feature events of the day are expected to be the 120-yard high hurdles, the low hurdles and the 440. Otto Anderson of U.S.C. and Charles Daggs of Pomona will be the principal performers in the timber-topping events. There has been much discussion as to which was the best hurdler in the South and tomorrow this will be decided. Daggs is the favorite in the high, while Anderson seems to have the best chance of winning in the lows. Yale Martz should have a chance to show how fast he can go in the quarter tomorrow, as he will have a number of fast boys against him.
