## BROOKINS SETS MARK

Charlie Brookins of Iowa established a world's record of :23 9-10 for running the 220-yard low hurdles around one turn. The mark broke the former world's record of :24 4-5, held by John Eller. The record was also a new mark for the games.

N. Anderson of Southern California put the shot forty-six feet, eight inches for a new games record, while Dehart Hubbard of Michigan boosted the mark in the broad jump to twenty-five feet six inches. Allen Hefferich of Penn State lowered the half-mile record to 1:56 5-10 and F. Tootell of Bowdoin tossed the hammer 175 feet one inch for a new games record. E. McKeown of Kansas State Teachers and J. Brooker of Michigan tied for first place in the pole vault at thirteen feet, which broke the old games record of twelve feet, six inches.
