Santa Ana High and Junior College Team Beaten

Peagreens Roll Up 70-to-43 Score on Opponents

Relay Provides Big Thrill of Bovard Struggle

Dean Cromwell's green-shirted University of Southern California freshmen tracksters added another scalp to their string when they bested the combined Santa Ana High and Junior College cinder-paths, 70 to 43, yesterday on Bovard Field.

The best race of the day wound up the meet, the frosh taking the relay from the Santa Anans by a yard margin after a nip-and-tuck battle all the way. Johnny Parsons, who took second in both sprints, started the final lap for the peagreens five yards behind Bear, Santa Ana anchor man. Parsons picked up a couple of yards before reaching the straightaway, where he opened up and passed Bear about five yards from the tape. The time for the half-mile was 1:35, good, considering the soggy condition of the track.

Al Clayer, former Stanford frosh grid star, competing for Santa Ana J. C., won both sprints in creditable time, with Parsons and O'Malley of the frosh close behind.

Santa Ana High has a good Southern California and State prospect coming up in Howard Paul, who captured the broad jump with a leap of 21 feet 8 inches. Paul jumped over twenty-one feet on all but one of his six jumps. Henry Coggeshall and Lee Barnes of the peagreens tied for second, each leaping out 21 feet 6 1-2 inches.

Coggeshall was high-point man of the fracas, winning the low hurdles, tying for first with Reynolds in the high jump and halving second place with Barnes in the broad jump. Barnes, Olympic champion, easily took the pole vault, clearing 13 feet 7 inches and calling it a day. Sahlbert of the frosh took both weight events, while Vawter won the 880 and mile for the Santa Anans. Summary:
