U.S.C. Yearlings Clean Up on Inglewood High

Bonham Stars for Peagreen Track Athletes

Draper, Borah Show Speed in Sprint Races

The U.S.C. freshman track team—the Olympic champions of 1938. Coach Dean Cromwell calls 'em—chalked up their first Cardinal and Gold victory yesterday, trouncing the Inglewood High team, 88 to 27, on the new Bovard Field track.

UNRUH OUT

Chealey Unruh and Hart Miller, stellar miler and high hurdler, respectively, of Cromwell's squad, were not among those present, and are due to be on the side lines for about a week, due to a technicality in the eligibility ranks. As soon as the principals of the two high schools from which the tracksters graduated have signed a transcript of grades the two will be ready to run again.

Herschell Bonham was high-point man of the meet, winning both the 120 high hurdles and the 120 lows. The latter event was run instead of the regulation 200. He negotiated the highs in :16.3.

Weldon Draper and Charlie Borah, sprinters, divided honors, the former winning the century in :10.2 from his team-mate, and the latter snagging the furlong in :23.2 in the easiest sort of fashion, trotting the final twenty yards.

Ed Gloege, Cromwell's nifty half-miler, had no difficulty in trimming his field in the nice early season time of 2:03.2. Gloege took the lead and was on top all the way.

With Unruh out of the mile, Ferguson, who gave the former high schooler some real battles last year, stepped out to win in 5:03, after Bryce Schurr had set a slow pace for three laps. Reese won the 440 for the high school team in :55.4.

QUEER RELAY

Inglewood also took the relay event. Cromwell's beaten quartet was composed of Smith, a miler; Allen, who took second in the low hurdles; Bud Elliot, a pole vaulter, and Ed Gloege, half-miler. The results:

120 high hurdles—Bonham (F.) won, Ferguson (I.) second, Johnson (I.) third. Time, 16.3-19s.

120 low hurdles—Bonham (F.) won, Allen (F.) second, Johnson (I.) third. Time 13.4-19s.
