## Speedster Grabs Off Two Speed Events

### Otto Anderson Features for Athletic Club

### Morton Kaer Chalks Up Fast Time in Low Sticks

With a number of the stars adorning seats in the bleachers, the U.S.C. track team won an easy victory from the Hollywood A.C., 83 to 24, in the Coliseum yesterday afternoon. The meet was supposed to be a practice affair, without points being kept, and not all of the events of a regular program were run off.

Ed House proved that he had entirely recovered from his attack of flu by trimming Keith Lloyd, Hollywood sprinter, in the century, and trotting away from his field in the furlong. He won the 100 in 19s. flat, according to the announced time, and the 220 in 23s. flat, although one watch caught him in 21.4s. Johnny Parsons finished in his usual whirlwind fashion to take third in the latter event.

While neither Ross nor Reynolds of the Trojans competed in the high jump, Henry Coggeshall elevated himself to a 6ft.-2in. mark. Morton Kaer, the Red Bluff Terror, appeared in a hurdle race for the first time this season and walked away with the low sticks in the announced time of 24.8s. winning by a good margin. Ken Grumbles, the I.C.A.A.C. champion, did not run. If Kaer had been pressed, he could have easily bettered his time.

Otto Anderson, former Trojan runner, was the feature of the meet. He competed in the shotput and running broad jump, both of which were held at the same time; and then galloped in the hop-step-and-jump and the discus, which were also held simultaneously. Despite these handicaps, he landed third in both weight events and second in the other two, for a total of eight points.
