

# FRESHMEN WIN EASY TRACKFEST

*Trojan Yearlings Gather  
Meet from Jefferson and  
Alhambra Preps*

The combined strength of Jefferson and Alhambra high schools availed little against the Trojan freshman track team in a cinder meet on Bo-  
vard Field yesterday afternoon.

Alhambra, which is rated as one of the leading institutions in the Coast prep circuit, gathered 10 points; Jefferson, admittedly a power in the City League, gained 19; and the frosh rounded up the astounding total of 108 digits.

The visitors failed to gather a single first place, and frequently didn't land more than one position in the first four.

Bert Darling, the up-and-coming frosh sprinter, as usual, copped both sprint events. Beaman, pole vaulter, soared over 12 feet 6 inches to take first honors in that event, and Leo Adams turned in a cheering leap of 21 feet 7 1/2 inches in the broad jump.

Patterson won a creditable half mile in 2m. 5 1/10s., and Woodruff, running another of his high-class races, navigated the mile in 4m. 43s. Jim Stewart uncorked a prodigious toss of 139 feet 9 inches to win the discus, four feet ahead of Frank Labes, his team-mate. The results:
