

U.S.C. ACE WINS BY TWO YARDS

Trojan Relay Team Equals World's Record

Turns in Mark of 41.6s. for Quarter-Mile

Webber Trims Welsh in High Hurdle Race

SANTA ANA, May 21.—Charley Borah, U.S.C. sprinter, defeated Frank Wykoff, Glendale High School sen-

sation, in a special 100-yard dash at the third annual Orange county A.A.U. meet here today. The Trojan runner finished two yards ahead of Wykoff in 9.8s.

Capt. Edgar House of U.S.C. was third and Russ Blocum of Glendale, fourth. There was a strong wind against the runners.

A U.S.C. relay

team composed of Borah House, Willie Lewis and Charles Sauers equaled the world's record of 41.6s. for the quarter-mile. Racing against the Hollywood Athletic Club squad, the Trojans equaled the world mark, largely through the excellent work of House and Borah.

The natives got a big kick out of the Trojans' appearance here. Friday night Dean Cromwell, U.S.C. coach, told Los Angeles newspaper men that Borah and his mates would not be able to take part in the meet, although the Borah-Wykoff race had been advertised all week. During the night Cromwell changed his mind and the Trojans went through with original plans, leaving here immediately after the meet to hop the U.S.C. special at Pomona. The boys are now well on their way to Philadelphia.
