

WOODRUFF IN WIN OVER COE

*S.C. Two-Miler Victor Over
Celebrated Card Ace*

*Spencer Runs Quarter-Mile
in 48 3-5s.*

*Ed Gloege Cops 330-Yard
Run in 1m. 55 3-5s.*

Sprinkled with several sensational surprises, the 1928 Stanford-Southern California track meet passed into history at the Coliseum yesterday afternoon while 10,000 persons looked on. "Dink" Templeton's mighty Cardinal team, scoring points in every event, won, 77 to 54, as expected, but the real thrills of the day came in unexpected quarters.

Warren Woodruff, a black-haired sophomore with a do-or-die spirit, provided the major upset of the afternoon when he trimmed Hank Coe, Stanford's celebrated two-miler, in as great a race as has ever been run in the Coliseum. The time, 9m. 47 4-5s., is but three-fifths of a second slower than the Southern California record held by Nick Carter, former Occidental distance ace.

THOUGHT COE A CINCH

But it wasn't Woodruff's time that was so sensational; it was the way he ran his race, the way he went after long-legged Coe at the start and stuck to his guns to the finish. Coe had been hailed on all sides as one of the two greatest two-milers on the Pacific Coast. Some said he was better than Hank Lunney, the Mercury demon who eats up miles as the ordinary man consumes hot cakes. Nobody figured Woodruff for better than second place. Coe was what the boys call a "lead-pipe" cinch.

But Woodruff didn't think so, or if he did he had resolved to be as close to Coe as possible at the finish. Coe had the lead most of the way, but on the last lap Woodruff made his bid for fame. Running stride for stride with the lanky Stanford ace, Woodruff battled him down the backstretch and around the third turn, where Coe moved to the front ever so slightly. It looked as if Woodruff was sunk, but he had that final spark of something which distinguishes a first-place man from a second-position performer. Coming around the final curve, Woodruff did his stuff, grabbed the pole and raced home a winner by ten yards. Coe, seeing he was beaten, faded badly and was slowed to a walk at the tape. He ran with a stick in his hands most of the way to get correct arm motion, but tossed the wand away on the final lap. His style is terribly awkward and how he gets there in such astonishing time is a mystery. Coe will be heard from later this year probably, but Woodruff, who is only a sophomore, has the more promising future.

GOT GREAT KICK

The crowd got the biggest kick out of this race principally because Woodruff's victory was so unexpected. They all knew Coe because

of the recent run over his eligibility. As it turned out, Southern California would have taken all three places in the race had Don not run, for Jim Hanny grabbed third and Blake Hansen was fourth.

Capt. Emerson (Red) Spencer, Stanford's remarkable 410 man, started the most sensational time of the day when he raced to victory in 48 3-5s, the fastest mark ever made in Southern California by a Pacific Coast athlete. Spencer was in a class by himself, winning by four yards over his team-mate, Johnny Morrison, who is a great quarter-mile in his own right. Morrison took the lead at the start and held it until the last twenty yards, when Spencer came up with that space-annihilating stride of his. Chick Hansen of the Trojans was third, a good three yards behind Morrison.

It was this race, the third of the day, that removed all chances of Southern California winning the meet. At the end of two events, the mile and 100-yard dash, the dope still stood good, Charley Smith and Melvin Draper finishing one, two in the century to shove Johnny Lauritzen of the Cards into third place. Alex McKinnon took the mile, as had been expected, and Tom Adams and Stewart Patterson of the Trojans picked up second and third.

MORRISON TOO GOOD

In order to stay in the running the Trojans had to shut Morrison out of the quarter, or at the worst relegating him to third place. They didn't, and they were sunk then and there, although, as things turned out a little later, Dean Cromwell's team might still have won the meet by taking the relay had not Jimmy Payne been disqualified in the high hurdles and Leo Barnes tied by Ward Edwards for first in the pole vault.

This chap Edwards provided the second major upset of the day when he cleared 11 ft. 6 in. Just as easily as Barnes did. Neither could do any better. Both tried 11 ft. 3 in. for a new world's record, but neither could cut the mustard. On the back of their showing yesterday, Edwards looks like he will make that height before Barnes does. The Trojans had doped Jack Williams for second, while Stanford had expected no better than second from Edwards.

Payne's failure to place at all in the high hurdles, where he had been doped for to win that second by everybody who made out a show. Finished the Trojans, coming as it did immediately after Morrison's second-place gallop in the 400. Jimmy was running fairly even with How Nichols of Stanford, but struck the fourth hurdle. This slowed him up and before the race was over he had tumbled over three more barriers, which automatically disqualified him. He finished a poor third in Clarence West of Stanford, but the third place point went to Webster, another Trojan, who was fourth.

Woodruff then pulled his spectacular victory in the two-mile and the Trojans took heart.

Lauritzen Ties Draper

But their hopes sank again when Lauritzen pulled up from behind to tie Draper for second in the 100. And then the results of the broad jump, showing Komore the victor, trickled in, and everything was all sewed up like a train's pants.

Cromwell's 100-yard race provided a surprise of considerable magnitude when they capped the first and second, only to lose the 1-point position when Bruce Selway was disqualified for asserted cutting in.

Ed Glasgow, in winning the race, equaled Percy Norbach's Southern California record of 1m. 33 3-5s. Glasgow was as pleased. Selway had more spirit than Tom Medicine of the Cards and took second by a couple of yards. Kirks, the third Trojan, waited too long before springing up, and as a result, failed to catch Medicine in the last twenty-five yards.

McKinnon, whom Stanford had thought good for second place, had to run so swiftly in the mile, he beat Adams that he had nothing left for the 700, dropping out after the first 400 yards.

Selway was disqualified, and Medicine given second place because the inspectors said the Trojan runner cut in without being two strides ahead of the Stanford runner. Personally, we saw nothing which would warrant Selway being robbed of second place. By no stretch of the imagination could Medicine have won second, so giving him that position seems unreasonable to say the least.

Crowd Didn't Like It

Bogart Rogers, a former Stanford man, was one of the inspectors who "detected" Selway's mistake, while Ed Lewis was the other. Whatever Selway did, if anything, it wasn't enough to warrant his disqualification. The crowd didn't like the verdict and booed considerably, most of the spectators not knowing what all the shouting was about.

Stanford's tremendous strength in the weights gave the Cardinals an overwhelming margin in the field, Tompleton's athletes scoring 41 points in but it picked up by the Trojans. It had been expected that Stanford would grab all 57 points in the shot, discus and javelin, but Bill Newberry of S.C. slipped in for an unlooked-for third place in the platter-spinning event. We said yesterday that it was doubtful if any team in the country could spot the Cards 57 points in the weights and win. The Trojans couldn't, even though they made against fight.

be desired. Charley is himself once more. His time of 3 4-5s. in the 100 found him a foot ahead of Draper, with Lauritzen more than a yard behind. Charley had plenty of drive at the finish, something he had not shown this season.

In the 100 Smith won by a little more than a yard, with Lauritzen running like a fool in the last three yards to tie Draper for second. This was a hard-fought race, the runners pulling every foot of the way. The time was 21 3-5s., with both Lauritzen and Draper only a fifth of a second or so slower.

McKINNON PUSHED

Tom Adams gave McKinnon plenty of trouble in the mile, the Card ace winning by four yards after the Trojan athlete had tried to take the lead down the back stretch and around the curve. McKinnon was "shot" when he finished. Adams has been running the 800 for the Trojans. McKinnon's time was 4m. 22 4-5s.

Payne came back in the 100 to win decisively in the splendid time of 22 4-5s. This is Jimmy's race. He's perfectly at home here, running easily and with all the confidence in the world. In the high he's bearing down and as a result of bearing down so strenuously he doesn't always lay the timber. Glasgow beat West out for second.

The high jump was a disappointment. Bob King, who has done better than 55, 56s, having to clear only 52. 11m. to win. Al Bowen and a newcomer, Karl Trölinger, both Trojans, took second and third at 51. 11m.

Fred Komore's leap of 34ft. 11m. gave him quite an edge over Jose Hill of the Trojans in the broad jump. Hill did 33ft. 8 1-2m., with Dyer of Stanford third.

The relay was all Stanford. With the most settled, Cromwell did not elect to run Bench and the Cards had no trouble winning by 60 yards in 1m. 21 1-5s. Morrison is a fine quarter-mile and when you put him on a team with Spencer the opposition doesn't get much of a look-in. It is very doubtful if the Trojans could have won the relay with Bench running, even had the meet depended on the outcome.

BREAKS SCHILLER'S RECORD

Spencer's mark of 48 3-5s. breaks the Southern California record set by Steve Schiller of the Trojans at Pasadena in 1928. Schiller's time was 48 4-5s. Driscoll, the old Boston College runner, did 48 2-5s. in the A.A.U. nationals at Pasadena in 1927 for the fastest time ever recorded in this region.

Tompleton has a wonderful track team. How the Cards can lose the 100-4-0's this year is hard to figure.

Southern California is to be congratulated on a game fight against overwhelming odds. Cromwell could have used Clark, Miller, and Newberry, javelin tosser, very nicely yesterday. Unfortunately the boys stumbled over their books.
