

ANOTHER FREAK RECORD FALLS BEFORE PADDOCK

SANTA BARBARA, June 9.—Charlie Paddock set an unofficial world's record for the 85-yard dash in an exhibition track meet of Los Angeles Athletic Club members here this afternoon, galloping the distance in 8 1-5s., to shatter the former mark of 9s. set by Baker in 1886.

Paddock beat Ralph Gilbert of Santa Barbara High School to the 85-yard mark by six inches and continued on to win the 100 in 9 3-5s., with Gilbert less than a yard behind him. Cooper of Santa Barbara high was third.

What the meet lacked in quantity was made up in the quality of the competitors. In some events, only one man competed, but other

runners were quite willing to set the pace.

Levi Casey came within six inches of the Pacific Coast record in the hop, step and jump, hurling himself 47ft 8in. to beat out his team-mate, Bob Patton, national junior champion.

A relay team composed of Gilbert, Frank Lombardi, Sandy Wehner and Paddock beat a quartet composed of Howard, Clark, Cooper and Jeddy Welch in a 440-yard event in the time of 42 2-5s. A previous attempt to set a new relay mark also failed when Pinney, running third on Paddock's team, pulled up with a bad leg.

1500-meter run—Won by Carter, Niersbach second, Regner (Santa Barbara) third. Time, 4m. 12s. Carter continued on to the mile mark in 4m. 25s.

800-meter run—Won by McGeagh, Burke second. Time, 1m. 58s.

440-yard relay—Won by team composed of Gilbert, Lombardi, Wehner and Paddock. Second team of Howard, Clark, Cooper and Welch, handicapped 10 yards. Time, 42 2-5s.

Pole vault—Won by Harry Smith, 13ft. 5in.; second, Ralph Smith, 13ft.

400-meter run—Won by Williams. Time, 51 1-5s.

400-meter hurdles—Won by Maxwell. Time, 54s.

Discus throw—Won by Moeller, 143ft. 7in.

Hop, step and jump—Won by Casey, 47ft. 8in.
