

TROJAN FROSH TRACKSTERS WALLOP GLENDALE COMBINE

The Trojan frosh track and field team added another victory to its rapidly growing string yesterday by trimming the combined forces of Glendale Junior College and Glendale High School, 71-46, on Bovard Field.

High-point honors were split between Ross Slocum of Glendale and Bill McGeagh of the frosh. Slocum took both dashes, the century in 10s. flat and the 220 in 22 3-5s., while McGeagh galloped to first place in the quarter and the half mile. The ex-Poly High star turned in a 50s. quarter, while he took it easy in the half, hitting the tape in 2m. 54-5s.

"Chuck" Anderson, star frosh sprinter, did not run. He pulled a ligament in his leg a couple of days ago and will be out for at least a week.
