

TROY BABE TEAM WINS TRACKFEST

S.C. Freshmen Capture Tilt from Jaysee All-Stars, 69-62.

Dick Barber, frosh broad jumper, and Henry Lassalette of Citrus Junior College staged the best jumping performance seen in Southern California this year in the Trojan frosh-Junior College all-stars' track meet held on the Compton High School oval yesterday morning. The meet, which was won by the frosh by a 69-62 score, was full of sparkling performances, but the work of these two was outstanding.

The Citrus J.C. athlete cleared 6ft. 4½in. on his first trial to beat Van Osdel of the frosh. Lassalette attempted 6ft. 6in. twice, but did not succeed in clearing the bar. Van Osdel also surprised in this event, with his 6ft. 3½in. jump. Dick Barber took three jumps, going over twenty-three feet at each. His best effort, which was 23ft. 10in., is the best mark made in Southern California this year. With a little more experience the former Long Beach boy should leap 24ft. consistently.

Jeddy Welch stepped over the high sticks in 14.8s. to lead the frosh hurdlers, Moffat and Vignola, by a few yards. Jeddy did not compete in the low hurdles, but stepped off a speedy 220 in the relay. "Red" Guyer and "Bullet Joe" Treharne, Jaysee stars, staged a battle in the sprints, the redhead winning both by a close margin. The time was 9.9s. in the century and 22.6s. in the furlong.

Hall of the frosh surprised the fans with a throw of 45ft. 7in. in the shot put. The big boy is developing rapidly and should prove quite a help in Dean Cromwell's 1930 Trojan varsity. Jefferson, Compton J.C. vaulter, took his event at 12ft. 6in. Halstead won the two-mile as he pleased in 10m. 27s. for the frosh. Bill McGeagh was pushed by Zellman of San Bernardino, but finished ahead by a respectable margin in the quarter and half-mile runs.
