

PHI KAPPA TAU RETAINS FRATERNITY TRACK TITLE

Phi Kappa Tau Fraternity successfully defended its inter-Greek championship at the University of Southern California yesterday, nosing out Sigma Chi 32½ points to 32 in one of the best meets in track history.

With the meet depending on the result of the hop-step-jump, the Sigma Chis apparently took the honors when Jack Sault, a swimmer, nosed out Jess Shaw, a football player, for third place. A check-up on the entries, however, uncovered the fact that Sault wasn't officially entered in the event, and he was disqualified, Shaw moving up to third place, which cinched the meet for the Phi Taus.

The complete point score was as follows: Phi Kappa Tau 32½, Sigma Chi 32, Sigma Alpha Epsilon 26, Kappa Alpha 25, Kappa Sigma 21, Phi Sigma Kappa 14½, Delta Sigma Phi 9, Theta Sigma Nu 7, Phi Kappa Psi 3, Delta Phi Delta 2, Delta Chi 1, Tau Delta Phi 1, Sigma Phi Epsilon 1, and Sigma Tau, 1.

Gene Clark, Spartan football player, won the 120-yard lows in 13.3, and ran a sizzling last lap in the eight-man-mile to bring looks of surprise to track coaches Dean Cromwell and Tommy Davis, who immediately singled him out as a varsity prospect. An unknown named Colton won the 220 impressively in 24.1, which was remarkable time for the heavy track.

Howard Joslin, another footballer, tossed the javelin 170ft. 4in. to

establish himself as a high-powered varsity prospect. Don Moses, inspired by a dinner wager with Al Wesson, the demon publicity director, won the twelve-pound shot with a toss of better than 47ft. The complete results:
