The best mark of the day was made by Johnny Johnson of the frosh, who jumped 21ft. 3 3-4in. to win the broad jump. The summary:

Shot put—Won by Nemethi (F.) 49ft. 3in.; Scharlan (F.) second, 48ft. 8in.; Brown (F.) third, 48ft. 2in.; Hamon (M.) fourth, 48ft.

Pole—Won by Grebert (F.) 11ft. 6in.; Brosnan (F.) second, 11ft.; Sullivan (F.) third, 10ft. 6in.

High jump—Won by Norcross (F.) 5ft. 11in.; tie for second between Brannon (F.) and Martin (M.) 5ft. 9in.
