

SPRINTER RUNS FAST HUNDRED

*Clocks Catch Glendale Star
in Under-10 Flat*

*Captain Hurls Spear Better
Than 195 Feet*

*Sophomore Hurls Platter
Into Far Country*

Frank Wykoff and Capt. Jess Mortensen performed sensationally at Bovard Field yesterday, when the sophomores, as expected, won the interclass track meet. Wykoff was clocked in 9.7 for the 100-yard dash and Mortensen tossed the javelin 195ft. 4in., which indicates a couple of good seasons for those young men.

Wykoff was timed in 9.6s. by two watches and 9.7s. by a third, which was given out by Coach Dean Cromwell as the official time. He ran in a sweat suit in the 220, and Go (Red) Guyer, in sweat trousers, won the longer event. The "Red Rocket" was clocked in 23 1-5s., with Charley Parsons of the frosh second and Wykoff third.

Gerald Pearson turned in a very fast early-season quarter when he won the 440 in 50 3-5s., with Vic Williams second and Chuck Woessner third. Chesley Unruh stayed out of the mile, and Cliff Halstead, with his bum ankle in good shape, won in 4m., 35 1-5s.

Melvin Shine, ineligible freshman, ran fourth in the mile and took second in the two-mile a few minutes later for one of the day's outstanding performances.

Bob Hall, the husky sophomore tackle, hurled the discus 148ft., 10in., to show consistent improvement. Hall has been improving steadily and this toss indicates that he will be in great shape to oppose Krens and Rotherert of the Cards in the dual meet. Jeddy Welsy, not in very good shape because of fraternity initiation difficulties, won the highs in 15 1-5s., and Ernie Payne took the lows for 24 4-5s.

Hall also tossed the shot 46ft., 9 1/2 in. for first place. The sophomores were first in the class competition with 71 1/2 points, followed by the juniors, with 28, the frosh, with 24, and the seniors, with 21 1/2.
