

GREEK RUNNERS SMASH RECORDS

Many Varsity Men Found in Trojan Cinder Meet

Dean Cromwell uncovered a flock of prospective varsity material when the annual Trojan interfraternity track meet was staged yesterday on Bovard Field. Sigma Alpha Epsilon won the affair with a total of 45 1-2 points, but Cromwell was more interested in the fact that seven records were broken and two more tied.

Charley Parsons, Jr., son of the famous Trojan sprinter of several years ago and nephew of Johnny Parsons of more recent fame, galloped to victory in the 100 in 10 1-5s., tying the record, and tied "Chuck" Anderson in 22s. flat in the 220, setting a new mark. The time was remarkable considering that the athletes ran around a curve in the mud this early in the season.

Other prospective varsity candidates included Dick Learned, who won the mile in 4m. 44 3-5s.; Bob Teague, who won the high jump at 5ft. 11 3-8in.; McKenzie, who won the javelin with a toss of 186.6ft. for a new record; Kenny Gardner, who loafed to an easy new record in the 880 at 2m. 4s.; Joe Bills, who set a new record in the hurdles at 15.6s., and Delby, who copped the 120-yard lows in 13.1s. for a new mark.

Phi Kappa Psi, with 31 points, finished closest to S.A.E. Other finishers were Phi Kappa Tau, 26 1-2; Sigma Chi, 25; Kappa Sigma, 23 1-2; Kappa Alpha, 16; Gamma Epsilon, 3; Sigma Tau, 2; Sigma Phi Epsilon, 1; Phi Nu Delta, 1, and Phi Sigma Kappa, 1-2. Summary:
