George Warriner Wins Both Sprints in Good Time

Harper Beters 46 Feet in 16-Pound Shot

Paul Takes Spill in Low Hurdle Race

The Trojan freshmen lost their first track meet in many years yesterday, when they bowed to the strong Compton Junior College runners by a 66 3-4 to 64 1-4 score. The meet was held on the Compton oval and produced many good marks and close races. The Trojans competed without the services of Alvin Keonig, their star sprinter, and received another tough break when Norman Paul, who was leading the low-hurdle race at the halfway mark, tripped and was unable to finish.

George Warriner won both sprint events, winning the 100 in 10 flat and the 220 in 22 flat. Dave Foore annexed the quarter-mile in 50.2s., while Jimmy Lawrence took the mile in 4m. 35s. Hueston Harper and Williamson featured in the field events, the former throwing the shot 46ft. 8in. and the latter winning the javelin at 176ft. 3 3-4in.
