

TROJAN FROSH BEAT SPARTAN RUNNERS

With Alvin Koenig winning the century in 9 4-5s. the Trojan frosh beat a team composed of second varsity and ineligibles known as the Trojan Spartans yesterday afternoon at Bovard Field. Paul Van Riper of the Spartans chalked up the best performance of the day winning the broad jump at 23ft. 4in. Because of his good showing yesterday Van Riper may compete on the Trojan varsity against the Olympic Club today.
