

# Graber Star of Coliseum Cinder Classic

They'll be talking about young Bill Graber of the University of Southern California for some years to come. This sophomore pole vaulter rose, and the word is used advisedly, to unexpected heights yesterday when he cleared 13ft. 6in., tied for first place in the altitudinous event and thereby gave his alma mater victory over the Los Angeles Athletic Club team. The score was 66½ to 64½.

More than 10,000 fans held their seats until this youngster failed in three attempts to clear 13ft. 9in., but while he was falling, so was George Jefferson of the club, and that meant victory for Dean Cromwell's team.

Graber's spectacular feat was only slightly more surprising than the inability of Lee Barnes, 1924 Olympic Games champion, to get better than a tie for third place at 13ft. Barnes, in two previous meets this season, had cleared 13ft. 9in. and 13ft. 6in. Had he tied for first, along with Graber and Jefferson yesterday, it would have given the Mercuries the meet. Graber never bettered 13ft. until a week ago.

At that, it was a twice-reversed ruling of the judges in the 100-yard dash which gave Southern California first honors. When the results were first announced Frank Wykoff was the winner. Milton Maurer of S.C. was second and Kenny Robinson of the club third. From the stands it appeared as if Robinson was entitled to second. From the field the result appeared to be no worse than a dead heat for Maurer.

## CHANGE AGAIN

Half an hour after the race had been run the officials reversed their decision, giving Robinson second. Then, late in the afternoon, when it appeared that Boyd Comstock's team had the meet all sewed up, which they did at this stage, another official announcement came over the loud speaker: Maurer second, Robinson third."

And with the announcement went two precious Mercury points and victory in the meet.

"An atrocious decision cost us

the meet," said Comstock after it was all over.

"Will there be any protest?" was asked at first.

"No, not as far as I'm concerned, but you can say for me that Robinson was clearly entitled to second place."

The three-reversed decision came about in this manner. Two second place judges picked agreed on Maurer. One third place judge picked Robinson, the other chose Maurer. When the first reversal was made, it came on the basis that the head judge had a vote and that he had favored Robinson.

Referee Francis Daugherty was appealed to, dug up the rule book and found that no original decision may be reversed, and also that no head judge ever has a vote anyway. So that settled the matter two ways.

The meet fairly sparkled with brilliant and thrilling performances.

The spine-tingling finish, which kept the entire assemblage on pins and needles as Jefferson and Gruber aimed at new heights, was hardly less spectacular than many of the preceding events.

Cumstock's team of forgotten men, ancient gentlemen with an indomitable will to win, last points where they figured to win, but showed their fighting spirit by getting the digits back in events where all appeared lost. The Trojans were not without their fighters, either, and it was the dogged determination of old Chester Ulrich when faced the prospect of Troy to see efforts in the closing minutes of a great afternoon.

Ulrich, running without splitters in shoes equipped with raised rubber heels to soften the pounding on his tender Achilles tendon, won the two-mile in the fastest time ever made by a Trojan athlete, 46. 43. Elmo, the five-toned leader, had been a prohibitive favorite and with the entry of Earl Callahan into the race it appeared that Ulrich would be lucky to place third.

But Elmo was all geared up yesterday. He stuck with Elmo and Callahan lap for lap and then gave 'em the gun down the back stretch, matching stride for stride with Elmo in an pulse-quickening a duel as local fans over saw. Callahan, the leader, began to fade and it was Ulrich who refused to break in the terrific struggle with Elmo. Coming around the curve Ulrich forged ahead and, with fans cheering him on, the stout-hearted Trojan crept up on Callahan. With plenty of steam to spare, Elmo then slowed down and jockeyed for his team-mate to finish in a tie with him. But Callahan, who has been 33, tagged so suddenly that Ulrich was unable to get on the brakes sufficiently to prevent winning by a yard, with Elmo three yards back.

Vic Williams, who, like Ulrich, seems to improve with age, ran the 440 in 45 1-50, thereby shattering one-fifth of a second off his own Southern California record made one week ago. Vic is going to give Ben Eastman the battle of that young man's life at Stanford on May 1 next. Five Williams surprised by beating Wessner for second place.

Cliff Haisland apparently does not know his own speed. Having shown remarkable improvement in every race to date, the powerful Trojan miler went out yesterday and beat Cyril Martin, former Purdue star, in 42. 12 2-50, the fastest time ever made by an S.C. miler. Haisland was just too strong for Martin and, although Cyril put on his famous sprint at the finish, Cliff had the power that counts and won by four yards.

### GREAT BATTLE

Every morning race was a roller, but the 800 took the cake when it came to maneuvering between Cumstock and Cromwell. This featured the much-debated duel between Bill McCreagh and Justice Barton. Cromwell went to Hammett to get an pace setter and kill Barton off. Comstock went to Ray Dodge, former Olympic Games star, as his pace setter and Dodge literally ran the legs of McCreagh after taking the lead away from Hammett.

The first lap, thanks to the pace-setting battle between Hammett and Dodge, was turned in 50. 34, which was too fast for McCreagh, who wilted badly at the tape and placed fourth behind Fitzmaurice. Barton showed tremendous reserve strength and a fine sprint to win in 1m. 35 1-50, for a new Southern California mark. Someone of the club, beaten for third in the mile by Learned of S.C., came back with splendid drive to place second behind Barton and then help secure a third speed as surprising as S.C.'s late-win in the two-mile.

Comstock's surprise show runner, Tom Pickett, won the event at 1:49. 46., followed by Herman Eric and Bud Hoover. This clean sweep, which is what Boyd had threatened all along, appeared to clinch the meet for the Mercuries, and would have, but for the queer decision in the 100. Thus Gruber is today's hero where Pickett would have rated that honor had Robinson been given second in the century. Pickett is one of Comstock's coaching mainstays. He never threw better than 1200, in competition while attending school in Arkansas. Bud Hall failed to qualify yesterday and that was a surprise.

Aside from the 440, 800 and two-mile, a new Southern California record was established in the relay with Oswald, Cow, Wessener and Williams turning the distance in 2m. 13 4-50.

### GREAT TIME

This is phenomenal time and has been beaten only once in the history of American intercollegiate competition. Last year in the S.C.-Stanford meet at Occidental, Stanford's great team of Stone, Howell, Hables and Morrison chalked up a mark of 2m. 13 1-50.

The sensational feature of yesterday's sparkling relay performance is that Cromwell can probably find a better fourth man than Oswald, who ran 58 4-50, for the slowest time of the quartet. Dow was clocked in 45 2-50, Wessener in 48 1-50 and Williams in 41 2-50.

Bill Cain equaled the Southern California mark of 23 2-50, by the way, closely followed by Capt. Ernie Forns.

Wykoff's sprinting, which is taken for granted by all of us and therefore fails to get the play accorded other events, showed that Frank is possessed of all his old-time speed. His time of 33 1-50, in the finishing was particularly pleasing in this race with Her Dyer at Stanford may be the deciding factor of the big meet.
