

Trojan Frosh Trim Pasadena

The Trojan freshman track-and-field team hung up a 75½-to-46½ victory over the combined Pasadena Jaysee and High School yesterday on the Bulldogs' cinderpath. A sprint duel between Al Fitch of the high school and Alvin Koenig of the Trojans was the sensation of the meet. They tied for first in the century in the fast time of 9 8-10s., while Fitch won by inches in the 220. The time was 21 8-10s. Norman Paul proved the individual star of the affair, winning the broad jump at 22ft. 10in. and taking the low hurdles in the excellent time of 24 7-10s. The summary:
