

OLYMPIC YEAR BIG INCENTIVE

Outstanding Performances
of Season Listed

Trojan Stars Hang Up Most
Records Thus Far

Draper, Prep Flash, Has Best
Marks in Sprints

Despite the fact the track season is barely under way performances throughout Southern California are considerably above par. Probably the Olympic Games this summer offer the incentive, encouraging local track demons to better and better times and distances as the season progresses.

Even the preps come in for their share of glory with diminutive Fay Draper of Huntington Park High having the fastest furlong time of any sprinter in the State. Draper, with a wind at his back, galloped the 220 yards in 21s. last week. His time of 9.6s. in the century ties the best 100-yard-mark performance, made by Frank Wykoff early in the season.

The Trojans have the majority of the best marks in the Coast Conference group, while the Oxy Tigers take honors in the Southern California Conference.

Quite a few of these startling performances will be shattered this week-end, with scores of prep meets scheduled, the all-star Jay-see squad taking on the California Bears, U.C.L.A. entertaining the Oxy Tigers and Pomona playing host to both Whittier and the strong L.A.A.C. team.

At Stanford the Indians are taking on a combined team from the Olympic Club and S.F.U.

This afternoon six City League dual meets are scheduled, which will find Poly at Fremont, Belmont at Manual Arts, Los Angeles at Jefferson, Fairfax at Hollywood, Lincoln at Roosevelt and Franklin at Garfield.
