

# TROJAN FROSH NOSE OUT CUBS

*Los Angeles Jaycee Beaten  
by One-Point Margin*

*James (Red) Abbott Gallops  
Hundred in 9.9s.*

*Arlo Munch Hero of Meet  
for S.C. Team*

Future Olympic greats fought for supremacy yesterday on the same battleground that staged the historic Games last summer, the Olympic Stadium, nee Coliseum. When the last gun had been fired, the last discus thrown and the final race run, a half-dozen mathematicians disguised by Trojan letter-men sweaters announced that the S.C. freshmen had nosed out the Los Angeles Jaycee squad, 66-65.

Not for many a moon has such a close contest been staged in Southern California. With the discus, broad jump and relay still to be heard from the Cubs and the Trobables were deadlocked, 54-54.

Green won the broad jump for the Cubs, nosing out Crawford and Itria of S.C. by inches. Coverly, Rout, Hickerson and Dalton won the relay easily to put the junior collegians into a nice lead.

A second place in the discus would give the meet to Harry Campbell's Cubs, but the effort was too great. Ken Carpenter and Arlo Munch, stalwart Trobabe weight men, annexed the two top spots, giving the victory to Ed Leahy's outfit by the 1-point margin.

If there was any hero of the day it was stocky Munch, who won the javelin previously in the afternoon with a gigantic heave of 171ft. Considering it was Munch's first experience throwing the spear, it would seem likely that Rev. Dean Bartlett Cromwell will discover a great javelin prospect next year, when Mr. Munch becomes a sophomore.

James (Red) Abbott showed that his 9.7s. race earlier in the season was no flash in the pan by leading the 100-yard field by a good yard and one-half to win in 9.9s. Johnny McCarty tied Snyder of L.A. for second. John won the furlong later in the day in 22.2s. with Abbott on the side lines.

Outstanding performers for Los Angeles included Al Hammer, who won the high hurdles in 15.3s.; Marvin Hart, who won the mile in 4m. 35.8s., and Carroll Lewis, who took the two-mile in 10m. 5s.
