Bill Sefton, former Poly High vaulter, turned in by far the outstanding performance of a triangular meet punctuated by good marks when, vaulting under the colors of U.S.C. Junior College, he sailed over the bar at 14ft, even yesterday afternoon at Los Angeles Junior College. Sefton's feat was easily outstanding. He cleared this height by five inches but failed thrice when the bar was set up three inches higher and called it quits.

The Trojan freshmen conquered the Los Angeles jaysee squad for the second year in a row by a 66 1-3 to 58 1-3 count, but only after the relay was run. The Trobabes had 60 1-3 points with the discus and relay results to come in. They won the relay with Coates, Ray Cartwright, Southern California halfmile champion two years ago. George Boone and Ross Bush, former Texas prep star who won the interscholastic half-mile title last year, defeating the Cub quartet in 3m. 27.8s. Los Angeles grabbed 8 points in the when Hankey tossed the saucer 137ft. 31/2 in. and Phillips took second.

Phil Cope, Herman Bruce and Roy Staley ran a fast flight of high timbers, finishing in that order with but a yard separating the trio. The time was 15s, flat. In other close races, Johnny Snyder, L. A. sprinter, nosed out Gordon Minor of L. A. and George Boone of the freshmen in 9.9s. Boone came back to tie, Minor in the furlong, however, Both were clocked in 22.4s.

Marvin Kingsley, former Hoover High School weight star, captured both his specialties, winning the shot with a heave of 46ft. lin. and wafting the javelin out 164ft.
