Compton Jaycee Victorious in Coliseum Meet

McCarthy Does 13 Feet to Best Yearling Star

Clark Crane Annexes Three Events in Affair

Justin McCarthy, Compton Jaycee pole vaulter, sprang a mild upset yesterday afternoon by besting Bill Sefton, Trojan junior-college vaulter, as the Tartars trampled on Coach Eddy Leahy's University of Southern California frosh squad and Jaycee team in a three-way meet marked by sparkling performances at the Coliseum. The scores were: Compton J.C., 75; Trojan Freshmen, 52½; S.C. Junior College, 3½.

Sefton could clear but 12ft. 6in. in competition with McCarthy, who scaled an even 13ft. Earl Meadows, Sefton's team-mate, deadlocked with Outler of Compton for third.

Clark Crane, former Junior Pentathlon athlete, and George Boone, Probabe sprinter, put on a battle in both dashes and broad jump, with Crane edging out Boone in all three events by narrow margins. The marks were 10s., 21.9s. and 21ft. 11 3-4in.

The Tartars scored heavily in the field, grabbing five of the six top spots. Frank Parks threw the plate out 142.95ft. Cornelius Johnson, Compton's great jumper, leaped 6ft. 3in., while Buster Boyer gave the spear a 163.25ft. ride.

In the first event on the program Pete Zamperini, Tartar miler, and his younger brother Louie, who hails from Torrance High School, ran a dead heat in 4m. 31.6s. Louie competed unattached. In other good performances Roy Staley, crack Trojan hurdler, ran a 14.9s. flight of high barriers and Ross Bush won the quarter-mile in the good time of 49.6s.
