**HIGH JUMP**—Won by Johnson (unattached), 6 feet, 7 inches; W. Marty (Olympic Club), 6 3/4; B. Marty (Olympic Club), Spicer (U. S. C.) and Thompson (U. S. C.), tied for third, 6:1 1/2.

**880 RELAY**—Won by U. S. C. team of Crane, Boone, Fitch and Draper; California, second; Fresno, third. Time—1 minute, 25.6 seconds (bettering world record of 1:25.8 set by U. S. C. in 1927).

**FOLE VAULT**—Meadows (U. S. C.), Sefton (U. S. C.), Graber (unattached), Maurer (U. C. L. A.), Warmerdam (Fresno), Maxey (U. C. L. A.), and Rand (San Diego), tied for first; 13 feet, 6 inches. (Sefton cleared 14; 8 1/2 in exhibition following competition.)
