

# ROBINSON IN DOUBLE WIN

## Prep Runner Stars in Oxy "Open" Affair, Good Marks Predominate

Promise of a great season ahead was given yesterday at Oxy's annual "open" free-for-all track meet at Patterson Field. Practically every cinder coach in the Southland was on hand. All had some sensational youngsters in tow, or maybe the kids had the coaches in tow.

Performances were very good considering it was the first real competition for all hands. In fact, some of the marks were so "hot" that the good-sized crowd fairly sized.

### ROBINSON STARS

Best of the day was Mack Robinson's double win in the 75-yard dash and broad jump. The Muir Tech colored kid beat Carleton Thoms in 7.5s. in the sprint and soared 23ft. 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. to take the long leap.

Little Ray Atzet, former Loyolan, hit 24ft. 11in., but fell back and had to be content with 23ft. 3in. for second place. Atzet was hot. He had two other leaps right around 24ft., but crow-hopped, so it didn't count.

Delos Thurber, Trojan freshman, won the high jump at 6ft. 3in., a mighty effort this time of the year. Bowkus, Los Angeles Jaycee ace, hit 6ft. 2in. for third, while Kerr of the Trojans and John Ogle, ineligible Oxy transfer, tied for third at 6ft. 1in.

### OLD-TIMERS

The meet brought out many old-timers who did very well. Ed Carrey, who holds the Oxy school javelin mark, hurled the spear 171ft. 10in. just for fun. Yaino Hoover, who was tossing the big toothpick for Caltech at least ten years ago, did 167ft. 11in.

Oxy would have won the four-man quarter relay if Mack Robinson hadn't been running anchor man for the unattached quartet which won. The Muir Tech speedster appeared to be in very good shape and had the "finish" which the other sprinters lacked. Robinson teamed with Casale, Pasadena Jaycee; Stedman, Fullerton Jaycee, and Atzet in the baton-passing event.
