S.C. Frosh Cindermen Trim

Compton Jaysee, 78-53;

Corney Johnson Stars

Featured by the high jump duel between Corney Johnson, just returned from the indoor track meet at New York, and young Delos Thurber, former Glendale High phenom, the powerful S.C. frosh cinderpath squad scored a 78-to-53 victory over Compton Junior College track forces yesterday at Boward Field.

Johnson, dusky Compton star, had to go up to six and a half feet before winning. Thurber stopped at 6ft. 5in.

Adrian Talley, frosh sprint ace, dashed to a 9.8s. win in the century, while La Fond, his team-mate who took second in the hundred, captured the furlong in 22.7s. Summary follows:
