S.C. First-Year Cindermen Defeat Glendale and Pasadena Jaysee Squads

The strong S.C. frosh track squad defeated Glendale and Pasadena jaysee teams yesterday in a triangular track meet staged at Bovard Field.

The undefeated Trobabes rolled up 73 points with Glendale taking second with 42 digits and Pasadena pulling up third with an even 20 markers. The frosh garnered nine first places.

Adrian Talley, sensational Trobabe sprinter, streaked to a 9.8s. win in the century while Skinner of S.C. took the century in 22.4s. The javelin was featured by the performance of two freshmen, Milner and Soper, each of whom tossed the spear over 200 feet, Milner winning with a toss of 206ft. Summary:
