

ROBINSON BEATS BUSH IN HALF-MILE BATTLE

Meadows Clears 14 Feet, 1 Inch to Win Pole Vault; Troy Wins Twelve First Places

STATE COLLEGE STADIUM (Fresno) April 13. (U.P.)—Irresistible, the University of Southern California track team continued on its way to its seventh national championship when it overwhelmed the Fresno State College by a score of 93 2-3 to 37 1-3.

The Trojans took twelve first places and tied for another out of the fifteen events with marks that far surpassed their efforts last week when they defeated the University of California.

Foy Draper, Trojan sprinting mite, led the Southern California attack, scoring ten points by two victories over Milton Holt of Fresno in the 100 and 220 yard dashes. Draper ran the 100 in 9.6s. and the 220 in 21 flat.

LANTZ STARS

Fred Lantz, diminutive distance man, tied for first place in the mile with his teammate, Francis Benavidez, and won the two mile in the fast time of 9m. 48s. to score nine points.

Fresno, whose team has been handicapped this season by a measles epidemic, won first places only in the 880 yard run and the javelin throw.

Elroy Robinson defeated Bush of S.C. by inches in the former. Javelin throws of 215 feet and 199 feet by Rowland and White of Fresno were far better than the best Trojan toss.

MEADOWS WINS

Troy's pole vaulting prestige was upheld by Earl Meadows as he scaled 14ft. 1in. to defeat his teammates Bill Sefton and John Hooker, and Fresno's Cornelius Warmerdam.

Warmerdam, Fresno sophomore who cleared 14 feet in an interclass meet two weeks ago, tied for second with Sefton and Hooker at 13ft. 9in. after apparently bettering the fourteen-foot mark twice. He was just leaving the pit after his third trial when the cross bar, still wavering slightly, toppled.
