The 440 vard team included Ad-The 440 yard team included Ad-rian Talley, Clark Crane, George Boone and Capt. Foy Draper. The group negotiated the quarter in 40.7s. thereby wrecking the world's record established in 1931 by an-other Trojan combination, namely, Roy Delby, Milton Maurer, Red Guyer and Frank Wykoff.
