

Trobabe Spikesters Beat Hoover

Scoring first place in every event except the shot, put and making clean sweeps in the 100, 120 high hurdles, and the mile, Coach Eddie Leahy's U.S.C. frosh track and field aggregation overwhelmed the Hoover High spikesters, 78-26, yesterday at Glendale.

Burt Bernstein, State hurdles champion from Texas, and Irving Bledsoe, city hurdles winner from Garfield, turned in the best performances of the day when they cleared the low and high hurdles in 24.8s. and 15.2s., respectively.
