

# Anderson Runs Century Dash in 9.8s.

University of Southern California's frosh track squad encountered its most stubborn opposition of the year in the Los Angeles Junior College team yesterday, but the Trobables finally snatched a 71-60 decision on the Cub oval.

Coach Eddie Leahy's Peagreeners were paced by Mickey Anderson, who raced to a victory in the 100 over Sinclair of the Cubs in 9.8s., the fastest time ever recorded on the slow jaysee cinderpath. Anderson then won the 220 around a curve in 22.2s.

Fred Hogans, dusky Cub hurdler, sprang the meet's biggest upset when he led Ivy Bledsoe, star frosh hurler, to the tape in a 14.8s. high hurdle battle.
