Tartars, 81-50

Compton Jaysee Outfit

University of Southern California's freshman track team, hailed as the strongest yearling outfit ever assembled at Troy, earned the right to that title yesterday with a smashing 81-to-50 victory over Compton Junior College on the Tartar field.

Excellent marks featured every event, but the Tartars, one of the top jaysee outfits in Southern California, contributed the feature, a 1m. 57.1s. 880 effort by Seward Mounday, colored speedster; as he outstepped Virg DeLapp of the Trobabes by a scant yard after a hot duel. It was the best Mounday had ever run and a couple of seconds faster than DeLapp's best.

Mickey Anderson of S.C. was a double sprint victor in 9.8s. and 21.9s. Bill Coleman, frosh, hurled the discus 150ft. 1in. Louie Zamperini loafed the mile in 4m. 24.4s. without any real competition.
