## HANDICAP LIST ANNOUNCED

After a week of painstaking work by Fred Johnson and Roy Priebe, coaches at Garfield High School, handicappings in the annual track and field opener between the University of Southern California and Occidental College were released yesterday. The meet will be held tomorrow on Oxy's field.

### MAY BE CLOSE

The Bengals were given nice advantages in every event, indicating that they may make the meet the close one that it was two years ago when Oxy took a 64-to-62 thriller from the Trojans.

Southern California fans will keep a close watch on both

dashes tomorrow. Barney Willis, a transfer from Sacramento Jay-see, will be making his debut as a Trojan. He is expected to fill the shoes of Adrian Talley, who was a consistent winner for Dean Cromwell last season. Willis is starting from scratch, proving that he is highly respected by the handicappers.
