

Zamperini Sets Record

Trojan Runs Mile in 4m 14.1s.; Day Beaten by Warmerdam

BERKELEY, April 29. (AP)—

Three meet records were broken and two tied today in the annual Pacific Association track and field championships, during which the San Francisco Olympic Club, as usual, won the team title.

The club squad, composed of former college stars, rolled up 85 points to take team honors for the 15th time in 14 years.

BEARS TALLY 51

University of California athletes, performing unattached, picked off 51 tallies; Stanford hauled down 39; San Jose State College 26; San Mateo Junior College 12, and Live Oak High School 4.

Four University of Southern California troopers, Jim Humphreys, Earl Vickery, Louis Zamperini and Loring Day, scored 18 points among them, but it didn't count in the official check-up because they were guest stars.

They did all right, however, Humphreys winning the high hurdles in 14.5s. and Vickery leading in to snatch the low-barrier event in 23.5s. Each clocking tied the P.A. record. Zamperini's mile-ran victory of 4m. 14.1s. clipped exactly two seconds off the former meet record, set by Cecil Cole of California, who ran second today. Day took second in the pole vault with a 14ft. effort.

NEW VAULT MARK

The vaulting event went to Cornelius Warmerdam, Fresno boy competing for the Olympic Club, who hit a ceiling of 14ft. 5 1/4 in. to better the 14ft. 4 in. meet record he formerly shared with Jack Mauger, a one-time club teammate.

The other meet mark displaced was the 10,000-meter run. The event, foreign to collegiate competition in the State, but big stuff in Olympic Games and A.A.U. circles, had 5000 spectators dizzy as Ed Preston of the Olympic Club chugged around the Edwards Stadium track 25 times to win in the time of 33m. 11.5s. The former record was 33m. 4.6s.
