

Troy Track Forces Rout Occidental

Southern California's national championship track team romped to a 81½-40½ triumph over an unbalanced Occidental College team in the annual handicap meet held on Patterson Field yesterday afternoon.

Stealing the show from the tried-and-true performers of Dean Cromwell's powerful aggregation were two S.C. sophomores, Willard Schaeffer and Gil La Cava. Schaeffer duplicated the mark he made at Bovard Field last week when he soared 13ft. 9in. to cop the pole vault. The bar was set at 14ft. but a measurement revealed a three-inch sag. Teammate Byron Dudley was second with a 13ft. 6in. vault.

LA CAVA IMPRESSIVE

La Cava, who boasts of a 6ft. 8in. prep mark, turned in a fine early season performance by leaping 6ft. 4in. The mark wasn't good enough to beat Oxy's Bob Kring, who boasted a nine-inch handicap, so La Cava was forced to share third with two Tiger leapers.

Mickey Anderson showed fine form when he led a fast century field in 9.8s. He later won the furlong in 22s. to take honors as the day's only double winner.

UPTON SCORES

Howard Upton overcame Bengal Ralph Woods' 14-yard handicap to win the quarter in the fair time of 49.9s. Art Reading ran a nice half-mile when he clicked off the two laps in 1m. 58.6s. to take first.

forget all about track. Hugo DeGroot, Peoples' colleague, got off a toss of 206ft. to take third in the event. Occidental's Glenn Hendricks had a 65ft. gift and this, coupled with his 179ft. effort, gave him 244 ft. and first place.

S.C.'s four-man quarter-mile relay team, composed of Cromwell, Richman, Prentice and Anderson, tore off the distance in 43.9s., to barely edge out the Oxy quartet.
