

Troy Piles Up Record 95-36 Win Over Tribe

**Stanford 'Surprises' With Three Firsts;
Peoples Sets 229ft. 7in. Javelin Mark**

PALO ALTO, May 10.—Southern California piled up the most emphatic dual meet victory in the history of its track and field rivalry with Stanford by a 95-36 margin today, but that wasn't as surprising as was the feat of the Indians in taking three first places.

One meet record fell under the impact of the Trojan onslaught, Bob Peoples heaving the javelin 229ft. 7in., to break his own mark set in 1939.

Stanford surprises were by Ambrey Seed in the two mile, which he won in 10m. 4s. when Jim Malone of the Trojans was used first in the one-mile run; Gene Kern of the Indians in the broad jump at 23ft. 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ in. and Emerson Hiler in the discus at 152ft. 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ in., although Carl Merritt had the best toss of his Trojan career at 149ft. 11 $\frac{1}{4}$ in.

Kern proved the meet's iron man in a very hot afternoon. Besides his broad-jump victory he took thirds in the low hurdles and shot-put, the latter event being one in which he had never before competed.

However, two Trojans, Cliff Bourland and Merritt, tied for high-point honors, each with a first and second place. Bourland took the 220 after being surprised in the 100 by Teammate Dean Rickman, who hadn't even been listed on the meet program.
