

# Davis Sets 220 Record

BERKELEY, May 3. (AP)—Olympic Club track and field forces, dominating the weight events, scored 68 points for an easy victory in the Pacific Association championships here today. One national record was broken.

Harold Davis of Salinas Junior College, national sprint champion, powered, against a stiff breeze, to win the 220-yard dash in 20.5s., 1/10 of a second under the national junior college mark held jointly by Davis and Clyde Jeffrey of Riverside Junior College. The world's record is 20.3s. by Jesse Owens. Davis also won the 100-yard dash in 9.6s., equaling the meet record.

## PEOPLES BEATEN

University of California's track team, competing unattached, finished in second place with 53½ points while Joe Batiste, hurdler from Tucson, Ariz., paced Sacramento Junior College into third position with 24¼ points. Stanford was fourth with 16½, and

the University of Southern California fifth with 14¼.

Batiste was a double winner in both hurdles and leaped to a tie for second in the high jump. He ran the 220 low hurdles in 23.9s. and the high hurdles in 14.9s.

Chief surprise of the meet was the upset of Bob Peoples, S.C.'s American native record-holder in the javelin, by Martin Biles of California. Biles, national collegiate champion, smashed meet and stadium records with a toss of 227ft. 11in. Peoples' best mark was 219ft. 10in.

## PETER TAKES MILE

Cornelius Warmerdam, unofficial world pole-vault record-holder for the Olympians, won the event at 14ft. 10in. for a new meet record, but failed to clear the bar on three world record tries at 15ft. 4in. In his first competitive effort in the half-mile, Grover Klemmer, California's quarter-mile king, won easi-

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ly in 1m. 51.7s., fast time but short of a record.

Dick Peter, ace University of California distance runner, shattered the mile record in winning the event.

Breasting a stiff breeze, Peter finished 30 yards ahead of Leroy Weed, University of Southern California, in 4m. 12.1s. The old mark was 4m. 16.1s. by Cecil Cole of San Mateo Junior College.
