

# O'Reilly Breaks Sprint Records

Jimmy O'Reilly, former Beverly Hills High track ace now competing with the S.C. frosh team, ran wild to break the 220 standard and tie the 100 mark in the sixth annual Southern California Irish-American Club track and field championships at Pasadena yesterday.

O'Reilly toured the century in 9.6s. to equal his mark of last year, and galloped the furlong in 20.7s., one-tenth of a second faster than his year-old record. The Los Angeles Irish-American Club won the meet with 65½ points. Summary:
